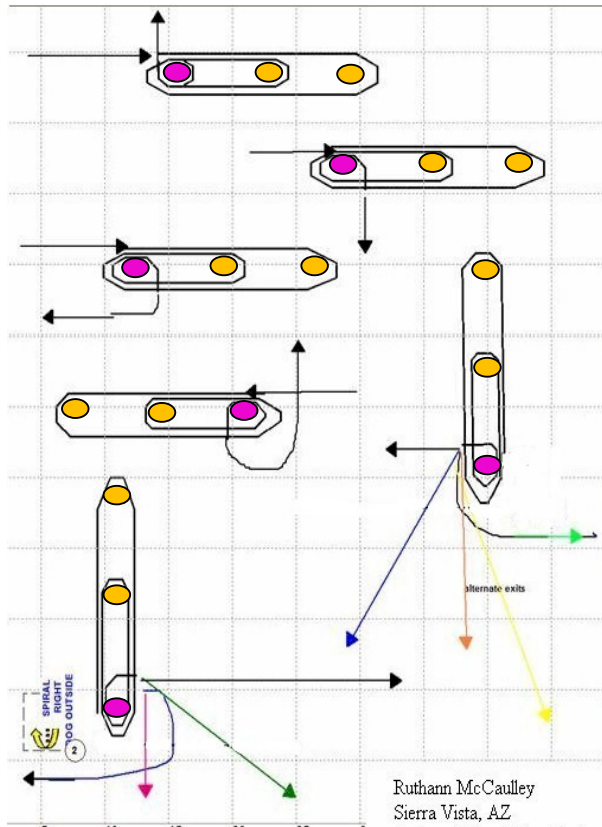
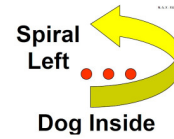


# RALLY O - HINTS & TIPS



## The "Spiral" Stations Stations 21 & 22

The Spirals are a handy tool for course designers as they can enter or exit from any direction. If you look at the diagram (left) you can see some of the exit possibilities (the pink cone represents the one with the sign).

**Hint:** Double check whether it's "Dog Inside" or "Dog Outside" before you start.

**Hint:** Spirals only have **3** cones – don't let a course fool you if there is another cone nearby – work out which 3 belong to the station and only do those.

Depending on the direction, go to the furthest cone and pass around it and then come back to the one with the sign. Then go to the 2<sup>nd</sup> cone and pass between it and the 3<sup>rd</sup> and back to the one with the sign. Then pass between the 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> cones and look for the next station. If it is in front of you, proceed straight to it. If it is behind you, keep going around the 1<sup>st</sup> cone until you see the path to the next station. You do not have to circle the first cone completely and then look for the next station.

**Hint:** You only pass between the 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> cones **once**.
